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### EXPLANATION.

Capitals of States, County Towns, Common Towns, Forts, Trading Houses.  
 The boundary of Oregon as proposed by the United States is colored blue and that proposed by Great Britain is colored red.  
 The emigrant route to Oregon, the route of Preliminary exploration, the Cassin route from Mexico to Santa Fe, and the Great Spanish Road from California to Santa Fe are all shown on the Map.

### EMIGRANT ROUTE FROM MISSOURI TO OREGON.

Emigrants to Oregon Territory cross the Rocky Mountains by the South Pass a gap of about 20 miles wide 31 miles at the head of the mountain or tributary of the South Fork of the Platte or Snake, cross Lat. 42° 23' N and the 107° 50' W from Washington or 107° 10' W from Coonick, 350 miles from the mouth of Kansas river and 174 from the mouth of the Columbia. The following are the round distances of the chief points of interest on the route. The first column of figures shows the number of miles from place to place, and the second of each place from the beginning.
